

# Bluer Than You™ Love Grass



**This southeast native compact clump-former excels in full sun in rocky, nutrient-poor soils, sandy pinelands, and live-oak woodlands. Grow the grass in beds, borders or in containers.**



## ***Eragrostis elliotti* 'WAH/EE' (Bluer Than You)**

- **Use:** This warm season grass is useful for erosion control and is an excellent choice for coastal plain plantings, rock gardens, mass planting, ground cover, and containers in warmer locales. Like the straight species its seeds provide food and cover for beneficial insects and small birds and is the larval host for Zebulon skippers. Turns blue-violet with turquoise accents in fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Reaching 2-3' tall and wide. A moderately vigorous grower that spreads by rhizomes.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-10, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Thin dark blue-green leaves. The foliage turns a pretty red-bronze in fall.
- **Flower:** White to tan plumes that provides nesting cover for ground birds and attracts butterflies. Plumes persist well into winter providing good winter interest.
