Purple Love Grass



Low Maintenance and we love to use the seed heads in

fall flower arrangements with zinnias and sunflowers!





Eragrostis spectabilis

- <u>Use:</u> The flower spikes of this native grass come to life by creating a pink "cloud-like" effect on the planting area while in bloom. Easy to grow and provides interest in all four seasons.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- *Growth:* Reaching 18-24" tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 5-9, Perennial
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Provides nesting cover for ground birds and attracts butterflies. The foliage turns a pretty red-bronze in fall. Grow the grass in beds, borders or in containers.
- <u>Flower:</u> Tiny reddish flowers appear in tassel-like inflorescences which rise above the foliage clump in September, gradually turning into silvery plumes in fall as the seeds mature. Plumes persist well into winter providing good winter interest.
