Isolepsis cernus or *Scirpus cernus* 'Live Wire'

- **Use:** What fun this Fiber Optic Grass is -- a whimsical little plant that also happens to be a year-round bloomer indoors and a boggy-soil lover outdoors! Use it in the children's garden, containers of all sorts, and in those damp garden spots where less rugged plants are unhappy. This is a great grass for mixed containers, giving them movement and interest.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun; Water when top 3" of soil is dry. This is a plant that will do great near water or in moist soils.
- **Growth:** It has a clumping growth habit, reaching 10-12" tall with a 20" spread at maturity.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7-11, Perennial; Can also be a houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; This grass has slender green foliage.
- **Flower:** The flowers resemble the look of fiber optic lights hence the common name.
