

Big Blue Liriope



Liriope muscari 'Big Blue'

- **Use:** An attractive, tufted evergreen perennial groundcover with arching, grasslike foliage. Superior edging or border for partially shaded areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring. Prefers moist, but not wet soils. Tolerates drier conditions when established.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and spreads to 2-3 feet tall over 3 years. Excellent for edging and ground covers. When plantings space 12-15" apart at least for fast display. Mow down with lawnmower to 3" tall in February for a clean look.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The dark green grassy foliage.
- **Flower:** Abundant blue flower spikes rise above the foliage in summer followed by clusters of black berries.

Low maintenance.
