- <u>Use:</u> Add year-long beauty with this drought-tolerant yet graceful plant. Flowing masses of white-edged foliage brighten containers and garden beds. Creamy yellow flower spikes compliment the fine foliage from autumn through spring. Thrives in tough areas. Ideal for use as an accent in smaller landscape spaces, home foundation plantings, or as a solo or in combination container gardens. In larger landscape borders use it in groupings, mass plantings in garden beds or on slopes for erosion control, or as a border along drives, paths and walkways or around low decks, patios and other outdoor living spaces.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. This is a drought tolerant plant once established, particularly when grown in some shade along the coast, but can also tolerate regular irrigation or even wet soils.
- *Growth:* Grows 2-3 feet tall and 2-3 feet wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 8a-10, Perennial Hardy to below 20°
- Foliage: Deciduous. Variegated green and white foliage weeps gracefully.
- **Flower:** Short spikes of fragrant yellow flowers in spring are an extra bonus.
