

Cabaret Japanese Silver Grass



Low maintenance and drought tolerant!

Miscanthus sinensis var condensatus 'Cabaret'

- **Use:** Rich green broad blades have conspicuous milky white stripes - a very showy ornamental grass that will assuredly add drama to the landscape. Copper-colored plumes appear above the foliage in early fall, age to a cream color on stems that blush pink as they mature. A bold accent or focal point for the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. It prefers soil that is well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay with a pH preference of an acidic to slightly alkaline (6.8 - 7.7)
- **Growth:** Fast growing; forms foliage clumps 6 to 7 ft. tall, 3 to 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. noted for its wide green leaves with a creamy, irregular midrib which form a substantial, arching clump. The foliage turns yellowish after frost, but quickly fades to straw-beige by winter.
- **Flower:** Tiny, pinkish-white flowers appear in tassel-like inflorescences which rise above the foliage clump (to 7-8') in late summer. Flower plumes mature to creamy white as the seed ripens, with the continuing flower effect of the plumes lasting well into if not through the winter.
