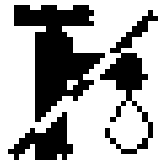


Fire Dragon Maiden Grass

Miscanthus sinensis 'Fire Dragon'

- **Use:** It your garden ablaze with upright green foliage that transforms into intensifying colors of red and orange in cooler fall weather. When the temperature cools, this grass heats up. Soft, silvery plumes and scarlet foliage give 'Fire Dragon' a dramatic fire and smoke effect. If left uncut, plumes provide long-lasting winter interest. works well in a variety of applications from garden borders to mass plantings or as a focal point. Once mature it is both drought tolerant and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. This plant tolerates some drought and occasional wetness. It prefers soil that is well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay with a pH preference of an acidic to slightly alkaline (6.8 - 7.7)
- **Growth:** Grows to approximately 6 to 7 feet tall and spreads 3 to 4 feet.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Graceful green leaves turn into striking fall foliage, in brilliant orange, vermillion & carmine tones
- **Flower:** Tan flower plumes are held well above the foliage in late summer– fall.
