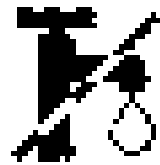


Oktoberfest Maiden Grass



Low maintenance and drought tolerant!
'Oktoberfest' is the gold standard in Miscanthus.



Miscanthus sinensis 'Oktoberfest'

- **Use:** Miscanthus is versatile from a design standpoint; it can be used as a specimen, for massing or screening, in large containers, or at the pond's edge. Plant this grass where its wonderful winter interest can be enjoyed. The foliage and flower plumes of ornamental grasses persist well into winter providing visual interest in the off season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. This plant tolerates some drought and occasional wetness. It prefers soil that is well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay with a pH preference of an acidic to slightly alkaline (6.8 - 7.7)
- **Growth:** Grows 4-5' feet tall, with flowers 6-7' feet tall. Clumps are about 4-5' wide. Cut old stems to the ground in late winter to early spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The wide, deep green leaves with a white midrib. In late summer or early fall, the foliage develops deep purple and red highlights which complement the showy flowers.
- **Flower:** Lush plumes grace the plant in early autumn, adding fall interest. Blooms September–November.
