

Little Zebra Grass



**Drought tolerant and
needs little water.**

Miscanthus sinensis 'Little Zebra'

- **Use:** Makes a tidy, compact mound of green foliage with prominent yellow horizontal banding that holds well through the summer. In late summer, the attractive plumes emerge wine-purple...a very good addition to smaller gardens. A versatile, easily grown clump-forming grass that grows well in any well-drained soil, from sandy to heavy clay.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 4 feet in height. Shorter than it's parent.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9 Perennial Grass
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The foliage is noted for its horizontal, zebra-like yellow banding. Foliage should be left standing throughout the winter for visual interest and to provide protection for the crowns. Cut foliage to the ground in early spring, just before new shoots appear.
- **Flower:** Wine purple flower plumes grow another foot above the foliage and persist into winter.
