

Pink Cloud Muhly Grass



Leaf blade color turns buff to copper in autumn as floral plumes rise high above the foliage, creating the namesake cloud-like effect. Don't let all that glimmers fool you: few plants are as rugged as 'Pink Cloud' Muhly Grass. Give them your toughest growing conditions, from sea spray to poor soils.

Muhlenbergia capillaries 'Pink Cloud'

- **Use:** A tough North American native cultivar. Slightly taller and more uniform in bloom than the straight species while retaining the open and airy appeal. Birds love the seeds. Superior groundcover when massed with shrubs and trees. Adapted to reflected heat, dry sites and poor soils.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part shade. Well-drained soil, not soggy. Drought tolerant once established. For fastest growth use slow release fertilizer two times a year!
- **Growth:** Fast growing clump to 3' tall in bloom and as wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The graceful, arching foliage is equally magnificent, providing movement and structure to mixed borders.
- **Flower:** Countless minute seed heads lend a dreamy soft-looking aspect, drawing plant aficionados as well as birds and floral arrangers.
