

White Cloud Muhly Grass



If you ever get a chance visit the Atlanta or Athens Botanical Gardens in fall to see their spectacular display of these grasses. Gorgeous drought tolerant grass for hot sun!



***Muhlenbergia capillaris* 'White Cloud'**

- **Use:** Masses of tall, delicate flower panicles create a peaceful white haze over the fine textured, leaves and are attractive through the winter. Superior groundcover when massed with shrubs and trees. Adapted to reflected heat, dry sites and poor soils.
Exposure/Soil: Full sun-part shade. Well-drained soil, not soggy. If you have red clay we recommend you amend the soil with a coarse sand for drainage. Drought tolerant once established, but prefers some occasional watering. For fastest growth use slow release fertilizer two times a year!
- **Growth:** Fast growing clump to 3-4' tall in bloom and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** White blooms September through November. Deciduous.
