

Cassian Fountain Grass



**Low maintenance,
deer resistant, and drought
tolerant!**

Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian'

- **Use:** Attractive grass highlighted by fluffy, buff-colored plumes arching above foliage. Terrific contrast when used among shrub or backdrop for perennial bed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower mounding to 1 to 2 feet tall, 1 to 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cut back grass to 1' tall in February to allow new growth to flush nicely.
- **Flower:** Beige plumes from August until September. Dried plumes add architectural interest to your winter garden as well.
