Cassian Fountain Grass



Low maintenance, deer resistant, and drought tolerant!

Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian'

- <u>Use:</u> Attractive grass highlighted by fluffy, buff-colored plumes arching above foliage. Terrific contrast when used among shrub or backdrop for perennial bed.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- Growth: Moderate grower mounding to 1 to 2 feet tall,
 1 to 2 feet wide.
- Hardiness: 7-9, Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Cut back grass to 1' tall in February to allow new growth to flush nicely.
- Flower: Beige plumes from August until September. Dried plumes add architectural interest to your winter garden as well.
