

# Little Bunny Fountain Grass



**Low maintenance,  
deer resistant, and drought tolerant!**



## *Pennisetum alopecuroides* 'Little Bunny'

- **Use:** The most dwarf of the fountain grasses with fluffy, buff-colored blooms. Terrific contrast for use in rock gardens, borders, foundation plantings, or in perennial beds. Foliage turns golden russet in fall. Adds interest and texture to containers. Drought tolerant when established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Slowly reaches 10 to 12 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cut back grass to 1' tall in February to allow new growth to flush nicely after winter dormancy.
- **Flower:** Cream-colored, tufted seed heads appear above a clump of dark green foliage in late summer to fall. Dried plumes add architectural interest to your winter garden as well.
