

# Piglet Fountain Grass



Low maintenance,  
deer resistant, and drought tolerant!



## *Pennisetum alopecuroides* 'Piglet'

- **Use:** Perhaps the most perfectly sized compact fountain grass. Its height falls right in between 'Little Bunny' and 'Hameln'. Great as an edger or in a container. Terrific contrast when used among shrub or backdrop for perennial bed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Dwarf-moderate grower mounding to 1 to 2(in plume) feet tall, 1 to 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cut back grass to 1' tall in February to allow new growth to flush nicely.
- **Flower:** Tawny colored, cascading plumes in late summer. Dried plumes add architectural interest to your winter garden as well.
