Millet glaucum 'Jester'

- **Use:** The foliage is really beautiful from the moment it opens bright chartreuse in spring, and as it changes to shades of red and bronze before darkening into a burgundy-purple richness. Even a small planting is quite striking, and a large display is breathtaking! No wonder it has already won the University of Georgia's Best of the Best Award for superb performance in trials!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Foliage will be more burgundy in full sun, yet is easier to grow in a little shade if you can't water regularly. Prefers evenly moist soil. Use slow release fertilizer for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows to 2-3' tall.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, Annual
- **Foliage:** Leaves resemble a corn plant, but are brightly hued.
- **Flower:** . The seedheads arrive in early summer, very spiky in 9- to 12-inch plumes that are ideal in fresh and dried arrangements.
