- <u>Use:</u> Reseeds to naturalize in meadows or on slopes for erosion control, though not a pest. Combine with Sedums and Asters or tuck into a rock garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established.
- **Growth:** Forms airy clumps 12 to 24 in. tall and as wide; 30 in. tall in bloom.
- *Hardiness:* 7-10 Perennial Herbaceous.
- Foliage: Delicate and graceful leaves and airy flower heads sway gently with the slightest breeze.
- Flower: Not significant.
