
Anne Marie Ivy

Hedera helix 'Anne Marie'

- <u>Use:</u> Beautiful leaves add rich texture to a wide range of landscape situations. Ideal as a ground cover, for erosion control on slopes, or as a vine for climbing tree trunks and walls. Add to outdoor combination planters or use for indoor greenery. Prefers humus-rich, moist well-drained soil.
- Exposure/Soil: Tolerates a wide range of soils, but prefers rich loams. Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in part shade to full shade. She performs at her peak in part to full shade but will put up with full sun as well with her best variegation in part sun. Some shade is ideal, but you'll be happy to know she does tolerate drought.
- <u>Growth</u>: Mature height 6-12", spacing 10-14". The saying goes-The 1st year it sleeps, the 2nd year it creeps, the 3rd year it leaps!
- *Hardiness:* 7-10, Perennial; Can also be grown as a houseplant.
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen. She performs at her peak in part to full shade but will put up with full sun as well with her best variegation in part sun. Some shade is ideal, but you'll be happy to know she does tolerate drought.
