Hedera helix 'Glacier'

- **Use:** Foliage bears a rich, emerald green coloring with high contrast, creamy white margins. A fast growing vine that roots as it travels, or climbs with clinging rootlets onto any vertical surface. Due to it's invasive nature we recommend you only use them in planters and keep them away from trees as they will grow up and choke out even 100' tall oak trees.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates a wide range of soils, but prefers rich loams. Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in part shade to full shade. It will also grow in full sun, but prefers some shade. Tolerates drought, best to let the soil dry out between watering.
- **Growth:** Mature height 6-12", spacing 10-14". ***The saying goes-The 1st year it sleeps, the 2nd year it creeps, the 3rd year it leaps!***
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial; Can also be grown as a houseplant in bright light.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Handsome triangular green leaves marked with creamy white
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers
