

# Yellow Ripple Ivy



**Hang on a shady porch, indoors or outdoors. Or create an elegant Window box with this delicate ivy.**

## ***Hedera helix 'Yellow Ripple'***

- **Use:** This ivy has 2"-3" stunning variegated leaves with golden margins. In hot weather the border becomes creamy-white, the leaves will darken in full shade. Contrasts well in containers or window boxes with blue flowers. Can be used as a groundcover as well in area where no foot traffic. Also lovely indoors in a sunny window.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates a wide range of soils, but prefers rich loams. Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in part shade to full shade. It will also grow in full sun, but prefers some shade. Tolerates drought, best to let the soil dry out between watering. Occasional misting will keep insects away that like dusty leaves.
- **Growth:** Mature height 3-6", spacing 10-14". ***Not invasive type, but still recommend you contain them and keep away from trees.***
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9b, Perennial; Can also be grown as a house-plant.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Silver-green and yellow variegated foliage, spring to fall. Can be toxic to pets.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers
