

# Champion Lenten Rose



## *Helleborus x 'Champion'*

- **Use:** Lenten or Christmas Roses are hardy and one of the first to bloom in the spring. Champion is a hybrid selection with matching vigor, beauty, and ease of maintenance. It forms wide clumps of dark green foliage topped with stalks of buds that begin rosy pink and open to a creamy white with pink backs. The perfect plant for naturalizing in moist, woodland areas where its extensive root system will spread as far as it is allowed. Deer-resistant and ideal in containers and window boxes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Prefers acidic, (most of our GA soils are acidic) moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12" tall and 18" tall -24" wide; multiplies well.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Foliage is a handsome silvery-green.
- **Flower:** Rosy pink buds open to a creamy white flower with pink on the back.
