Deer-resistant and ideal in containers and window boxes.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun-shade. Prefers acidic, (most of our GA soils are acidic) moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- *Growth:* Grows 13-16" tall and 20-24" wide; multiplies well.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Evergreen, virtually problem free. Compact, with colorful evergreen foliage, deep green leaves, lighter veins and red stems.
- *Flower:* Creamy white flowers with a dusty rose color on the backside of the petal.
