- **hardy, extra robust, ever-green perennial**
- **extra-large, upright flowers**
- **floriferous, some varieties starting to bloom in November**
- **low-maintenance, vigorous garden plant, also suited for large planters**
- **Disease resistance**
- **Use:** The Marble collection within the Ice N' Roses series features striking marbled evergreen foliage and red stems with the flowers being held upright. The flowers in this series range from pure white to rose-pink as well as deep reds and even some with picotee edges. The Ice N' Roses® series from Heuger is a new line of genetics that produce many vigorous and robust varieties in vivid colors. Most of the color choices in this series bloom from December to April with many holding their flowers well into spring. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade (Morning sun and afternoon shade for best blooming in the South). Prefers acidic, (most of our GA soils are acidic) moist, **well-drained soil**, but not soggy. Standing water = death for Helleborus.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-18" tall and 24-30" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free and resistant to Lenten Rose Black Death. Foliage is a handsome dark green marbled with white veins.. Remove any scruffy leaves in winter before flowering begins, and cut back flowering stems after flowering is over.
- **Flower:** Prized for its spectacular display of large, forward-facing red flowers, with a huge central boss of stamens, borne on tall stems Excellent for use as a cut flower. Sterile cultivar.
