

# Pine Knot Select Lenten Rose



Beloved by shade gardeners everywhere for thick evergreen leaves and winter blossoms in the shade. Excellent in drifts in woodland gardens.



## *Helleborus orientalis (Mix)*

- **Use:** Beautiful, long-lasting nodding flowers complement blue-green leaves. Highlights the woodland garden or landscape planted with hosta, ferns and early-season shrubs such as serviceberries and red- or yellow-stemmed dogwood. Long-lived.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 15" tall and 24" wide; multiplies and reseeds well.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Dark green leaves which are divided into glossy, leathery, deeply-lobed, often toothed, lanceolate to elliptic segments.
- **Flower:** A selection of unbloomed seedlings in mixed colors of the best single and semi-double hybrid hellebores which have been developed by Judith and Dick Tyler of Pine Knot Farms in Clarksville, Virginia. Large variety of color combinations and patterns. that bloom from late winter to spring.
