

# Wedding Party® Maid of Honor Lenten Rose



## *Helleborus 'Wedding Party® Maid of Honor'*

- **Use:** Hellebores are the harbingers of spring, blooming for six weeks or more beginning in late winter. They are often flowering during the Christian season of Lent, from which they get their common name, Lenten Rose. The WEDDING PARTY® series showcases his double flowered selections, available in numerous, beautiful color shades.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Prefers acidic, (most of our GA soils are acidic) moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Foliage is a handsome silvery-green.
- **Flower:** Large double blooms that features shades of medium to dark pink petals. Each bloom gets 2-3 inches across and is very floriferous. With blooms starting in late winter, it is known to bloom up to 6+ weeks, and after that the spent blooms are equally as beautiful for weeks longer. Float flowers in clear bowls for an elegant centerpiece.

**Use in winter combination containers with evergreens or enjoy it in the landscape. A must have for every shade gardener!**
