

# Cinnamon Snow Lenten Rose



Excellent in drifts in woodland gardens. They are also perfect for use in large containers for balconies and terraces.



## *Helleborus x ballardiae* 'HGC Cinnamon Snow'

- **Use:** This Gold Collection Hellebore is an absolutely wonderful introduction bred by Josef Heuger in Germany, this sturdy hybrid is gorgeous both in leaf and in flower. It forms a low mound of leathery, evergreen, dark green leaves. Pink buds appear in early spring opening to large, out-facing, creamy-white flowers that are streaked rose and cinnamon.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Just 12 inches high and about 12 to 15 inches wide, this Lenten Rose sports serrated dark green foliage and good branching as well as masses of elegant nodding blooms.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; foliage, virtually problem free with red stems. Older leaves can be cut back in late August to showcase winter blossoms better.
- **Flower:** Fantastic new variety adds a shimmering effect to shady beds. Pink buds open to large, creamy white flowers with shades of rose and cinnamon. Color is affected by temperature and flower age, resulting in multiple hues.
