- **Use:** The Frostkiss™ Hellebores series are some of the first plants to bloom in the spring. Although all Hellebore demand attention, the Frostkiss Hellebores will earn a special place in your heart. Beautiful, tough and easy to grow, their large, forward-facing blooms flower the first year and provide a lasting show of color. Beloved by shade gardeners everywhere for thick evergreen leaves and winter blossoms in the shade. Excellent in drifts in woodland gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-24" tall and wide; multiplies well.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Older leaves can be cut back in late August to showcase winter blossoms better.
- **Flower:** This cultivar offers tons of creamy, outward-facing, white flowers developing greenish highlights over incredibly mottled and veined foliage that is at first silver flushed with pink maturing to mint green on a dark green background. Begins blooming in January.
