

Frostkiss Moondance Lenten Rose



A must for color in the winter garden, but still heat tolerant in summer.

Helleborus x iburgensis 'Frostkiss Moondance'

- **Use:** White flowers fade to green on this vigorous selection. Leafy flower stems are held strongly upright. Soft-green veined leaves create a unique marbled look on a compact form. An excellent addition to a moonlight garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Foliage clumps 24 in. tall and wide. Slowly spreads. Sterile type.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Soft-green veined leaves create a unique marbled look on a compact form. Older leaves can be cut back in late August to showcase winter blossoms better.
- **Flower:** Topped with white flowers that have a chartreuse center and age to pale green. Grows 24" tall. Exceptionally long blooming from February to April.
