

'Candy Love' Lenten Rose



A must have for every shade gardener!

***Helleborus x ericsmithii* 'Candy Love'**

- **Use:** Beloved by shade gardeners everywhere for thick evergreen leaves and winter blossoms in the shade. Excellent in drifts in woodland gardens. A hybrid of *H. niger* and *H. x sternii*. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Prefers acidic, (most of our GA soils are acidic) moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 20" tall and wide; multiplies well.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-8; perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. *H. niger*-like clump of dark green leaves, highlighted by red veins in spring.
- **Flower:** The clumps are topped, starting in late winter, with massive clusters of 15" stalks ending in large pink tinged flowers which age chocolate...mighty fine!
