- **Use:** One of the easiest perennials to grow, Hellebores are indifferent to environmental stresses from heat and humidity to poor soil and even drought. They are poisonous, keeping diseases and pests at bay, and very hardy in almost any climate. This impressive new hybrid has perked up the traditional drooping flowers of hellebores with blooms facing outwards, and even upwards, to greet the late winter- spring. A delightful cool-season bloomer, a wonderful addition to lightly to deeply shaded beds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Prefers acidic, (most of our GA soils are acidic) moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Reaches 1 to 2(in bloom) ft. tall, 2 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Foliage is a handsome silvery-green.
- **Flower:** Large, upward facing dark red, saucer-shaped single flowers with yellow centers, above compact mounds of leathery, dark green foliage. Blooms from December to March with many holding their flowers well into spring.
