Elegant Candy Daylily



An crowdwinning rebloomer with its first flush in early summer then repeating on and off into fall.





Hemerocallis 'Elegant Candy'

- <u>Use:</u> Grow in mixed or herbaceous borders. Fully hardy, preferring fertile well drained but moist soil in full sun. Hemerocallis are really easy to grow, and need hardly any maintenance. The thick foliage covers the ground smothering weeds, and they are quick to establish. Extremely easy to grow --heat, humidity, drought, and poor soil tolerant.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- Growth: Growing to a height of 18-22" tall and 12-24"wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zones 3-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Semi-evergreen. Long, thin, green leaves arch gracefully.
 - **Flower:** 4½", medium pink flowers with a triangular red eye and a green throat Blossoms are round in form and heavily ruffled. The flower color is sunfast. Strong, well-branched and budded scapes. Notably fragrant rebloomer!
