

Fairy Tale Pink Daylily



The name, Hemerocallis is derived from the Greek for beauty and day because each flower blooms for just a single day.

Hemerocallis 'Fairy Tale Pink'

- **Use:** A favorite perennial for its showy pinkish apricot-colored blooms. Large clumps of long, grass-like leaves are highlighted by lily-like flowers on tall stems. This selection reblooms throughout the summer months. Winner of the 1990 Stout Silver Medal – daylily's highest award.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Foliage clumps reach 2 ft.tall and wide, flower stalks to 3 ft. tall. Daylilies are clump-forming and multiply freely.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 4-11; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** The stunning blooms are a gentle, pastel pink color with a green throat and ruffled recurved petals! IT GLOWS! It never fails to please when it opens up those gorgeous blooms, making it great for the front of the flowerbed. This is a REBLOOMING variety! It's a large flowered daylily, with blooms that are 5.5" in diameter, and it has a long bloom period!
