Hemerocallis 'Fragrant Returns'

- **Use:** Lemon yellow, sweetly fragrant daylily blooms non-stop from early summer into fall. Compact plants have more refined foliage than standard daylilies. A good choice for perennial gardens. Extremely popular perennial. Daylilies are adaptable to a wide range of growing conditions and are very easy to grow. Once established, daylilies are very drought and heat tolerant, and are extremely long-lived.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** These outstanding varieties produce mounds of 18-20" tall foliage and bloom on stems up to 15-24" high.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen.
- **Flower:** Light lemon yellow, slightly ruffled, 3 1/4" flowers that are very fragrant and stay open into the evening make this a plant destined to be a garden standout.
