- **Use:** One of the very best purple reblooming daylilies, MacBeth has large 6-in, lavender-purple, ruffled flowers with dark purple centers and green-yellow eye zones. Daylilies are some of the easiest perennials to grow and a good choice for any gardener. They are tough, adaptable plants that will grow in any soil, from normal to slightly wet to dry.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to a height of 18-24 inches and has a spread of 24 inches.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, thin foliage is a great compliment to large flowers.
- **Flower:** 5" mauve-purple blooms have wide maroon eyes and chartreuse centers. Petals have lighter midribs and ruffled edges. Midseason. Rebloomer.
