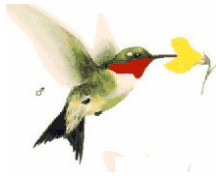


'Double Pardon Me'



Hemerocallis 'Pardon Me Double'

- **Use:** A popular, award winning daylily with bright red blooms. Its smaller size makes it useful in foreground plantings and other situations where a small, colorful plant is needed. This cultivar has been stated as somewhat deer resistant, but depends on the deer..... With its petite size, it is perfect to be used for ground cover and attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full- part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 18" high, flower stalks taller and 18-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 3-9;** Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green foliage.
- **Flower:** This ruffled beauty with double petals boasts a bold rosy red color providing distinctive flair for a landscape. A twist on the old classic! 'Double Pardon Me' has the same color as its namesake but with dramatically more tepals. Instead of the standard amount of 6 tepals, according to the breeder, these flowers can have as many as 18 tepals. The unique look of this daylily will get you talking-it certainly did for us.

This cutie's romantic red blossoms appear for a long time over summer into fall. Each bright red blossom is perfectly formed, and delightfully ruffled and fragrant. Rabbit resistant. A vigorous grower with a good bloom count. Its compact form and prolific flower show makes this the perfect daylily for growing as a ground cover, in the front of the border, and in containers.
