Hemerocallis 'Prairie Bella'

- **Use:** This deep pink, tetraploid daylily blooms in late spring, and may repeat throughout the summer for you as it does for our grower. It reaches about 20 inches in height, and is an excellent companion to Stella D'Oro. Performs best in moderate to warm climates with good disease resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Growing to a height of 28” and a plant spread of 12-24”.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen.
- **Flower:** This pink to rose daylily provides a nice contrast in any perennial garden. A somewhat large bloom stands out in any perennial garden. Repeat bloomer.
