- <u>Use:</u> A true showstopper, its deep pink blooms brighten any garden corner, from barren slopes to woodland edges. Each fragrant, 5" flower is exquisitely crafted with slightly ruffled edges and a lighter watermark that contrasts beautifully against the light green throat. This reliable rebloomer also features a high bud count of 25 across three branches. HAPPY EVER APPSTER™ Daylilies can survive many harsh conditions that other plants cannot including: polluted city environments, slopes, poor and dry soils, near pavement that is salted in winter, and under Black Walnut trees (not affected by juglone).
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 25" high and 18-24" wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 3-9; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Semi-evergreen. Green foliage is thin and grass-like.
- **<u>Flower</u>**: Deep rose pink flowers have ruffled petals with notably large flowers for a continuous bloomer at 5" wide. Compared to 'Passionate Returns', this is a deeper pink with larger flowers. Rebloomer and flowers stay open at least 16 hours. Fragrant flowers are diploid with 22 chromosomes. Early-midseason bloomer.
