Daylily 'Siloam Double Classic'



Can withstand heat and drought, and insects better than most perennials!





Hemerocallis 'Siloam Double Classic'

- <u>Use:</u> Best known for its incredible sweet fragrance, this daylily sports magnificent, full double blossoms.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full— part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- <u>Growth:</u> Fast-growing and when in bloom, this mid-size clumper reaches 16" tall and 16"wide. Plants do not usually require dividing for several years, but are easily split apart in fall or early spring.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-10; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. The mounding strap like foliage adds a textural element to the garden when not in bloom. Cut back dead foliage in late fall or winter.
- <u>Flower:</u> Beautiful clear peach flowers with a yellow halo and green throat. Petals have perfect pie crust edges and smooth sepals. Blooms appear in late June early July. Award winner. Reblooms. Remove faded flower stalks for best blooming.
