- <u>Use:</u> A real strawberry shade, not the peachy hues that are sometimes sold as "pink", this charmer also displays a pronounced rosy eyezone, darker petal edges and a green throat. This true pink daylily passed a stringent series of tests, proving to be more beautiful, longer blooming, hardy, vigorous and pest resistant than average varieties. Stout Silver Medal in 1998, the Award of Merit in 1996 and Honorable Mention in 1993
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full— part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Growing to a height of 26" and a plant spread of 12-24".
- *Hardiness:* Zones 3-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen.
- **Flower:** Has a wonderful strawberry-pink flower with rosy-red eye zone with a golden green throat and ruffled edges. It has a flower size of 4.5". will bloom from May through July, with outstand color and a definite reblommer.

An award-winning rebloomer with • its first flush in early summer then repeating on and off into fall.
