

Titan Skye® Daylily



Daylilies can survive many harsh conditions that other plants cannot including: polluted city environments, slopes, poor and dry soils, near pavement that is salted in winter, and under Black Walnut trees (not affected by juglone).

Hemerocallis x 'MON7091' PPAF

- **Use:** This prolific, reblooming daylily features huge burnt-orange flowers with exceptionally frilly petal edges and a bright yellow eye. This easy care compact plant tolerates a range of soils and can be tucked into nearly any garden to add reliable summer color.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Do not give too much nitrogen or they will not produce flowers. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Forms foliage clumps 12 to 18 in. tall, 18 in. wide
- **Hardiness:** Zones 4-11; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen foliage stays nice all season
- **Flower:** Features huge burnt-orange flowers with exceptionally frilly petal edges and a bright yellow eye. Repeat bloomer.
