Autumn Leaves Coral Bells







Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.

Heuchera 'Amber Leaves'

- <u>Use:</u> Truly a four-seasons plant, 'Autumn Leaves' changes its personality as the days grow longer. The H. villosa and H. americana parentage will help with heat and humidity tolerance. Try this plant in fall containers with mums and kale. Landscape Value Accent, contrast, spring and fall color, mass planting, container, mixed beds.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Part sun (afternoon shade)-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth:* Fast growth to 8" tall, 15" in bloom overall, by 15-18" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-10; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Semi-evergreen. Mid-sized leaves of red in the spring, taupe in summer, and ruby red in the fall, put on a show in any season.
- *Flower:* Dark red stems produce lovely sprays of small white and pink bell-shaped flowers above neat mounds of foliage over a long season.
