

# Carnival™ Cinnamon Stick Coral Bells



**Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.**



## ***Heuchera Carnival™ Series 'Cinnamon Stick'***

- **Use:** Heuchera Carnival Cinnamon Stick has *H. villosa* parentage for excellent heat tolerance and outstanding garden performance. Create a stunning display with beautifully textured, peach-pink foliage that transitions to a bronze-green. Tall, delicate flower panicles dance above the low mounded form in spring. Low maintenance and easy to grow - ideal for borders and mixed containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade (preferred in South). More sun tolerant than other coral bells. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10-12 "tall, 12-14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Chameleon-like foliage emerges rich red in spring. Throughout the summer, foliage transforms to warm bronze-copper and cinnamon hues. Cooler spring and fall temps flash more vibrant tones.
- **Flower:** White spires of flowers in spring open from pink buds.
