

Coffee Bean Carnival Coral Bells



Striking when massed in a woodland border or tucked into a rock garden.

- **Use:** Coral Bells Carnival Coffee Bean emanates fall tones with leaves in colors of amber, orange and tan. Petite bell shaped flowers arise on long stems from the base of the plant in early to mid summer. This evergreen perennial is easy to grow, deer resistant and requires very little maintenance. Coral bells look great planted in a container or as a border in a garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; foliage reaches 14-16" tall and 14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Rich, coffee colored foliage.
- **Flower:** White flowers hover above foliage in summer.
