

# Delta Dawn Coral Bells



**These deer resistant blooming beauties add a colorful splash of in the shade garden. Exceptionally heat and humidity tolerant.**

## ***Heuchera 'Delta Dawn' PP23545***

- **Use:** Large, round leaves with red centers in the spring and fall. In summer its red veins are prominent. The gorgeous gold to lime leaf color highlights the venation. Very showy year-round. A strong, vigorous habit. Use in mixed beds, borders, edging, and containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade (morning sun and late afternoon shade is ideal.) Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; 8-14" tall by 12" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. In spring, the large round leaves are red with bright lime-green edges. In summer, they're lime/gold with intricate red veins. Older leaves turn more green in warmer temperatures.
- **Flower:** Dainty flowers hover above the colorful leaves for months.
