

# Electra Heuchera



**This smaller type of coral bells is excellent for container gardening and is the most intense red we have seen!**



## ***Heuchera 'Electra'***

- **Use:** Shocking, blood-red veins electrify the golden leaves of this startling Heuchera. The red venation stays while the leaf changes from shades of yellow in spring, to chartreuse in summer and fall, and tan in the winter. Short, dense cones of white flowers. This vigorous, clumping H. villosa hybrid delivers what 'Tiramisu' promised.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 8-12 in. tall, 14 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Electric red veining remains unchanged while foliage transforms from bright green/yellow in spring to chartreuse in summer, soft red/caramel in fall.
- **Flower:** Short, dense spikes with white flowers in mid summer. Dance airily above the foliage.
