This smaller type of coral bells is excellent for container gardening and is the most intense red we have seen!



Heuchera 'Electric Lime'

- **Use:** The lime foliage forms a large mound with attractive flowers stems of white flowers. Foliage sports red veins in cool temperatures. Large leaves create full, mounding plants and look lovely in combination with Hostas and Carex. As a bonus, clusters of dainty white flowers appear on spikes above the foliage in the spring. Heat and humidity tolerant. Heat and humidity tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 12 in. tall, 28 in. wide and 16" in bloom.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Lime foliage. Red veins in cool temperatures on huge leaves.
- **Flower:** The 14" spikes with white flowers in mid summer. Dance airily above the foliage.
