

Fire Chief Premium Coral Bells



Heuchera 'Fire Chief'

- **Use:** Fantastic wine-red foliage matures with maroon markings, adding fantastic color towards the front of the border. This shade loving perennial will tolerate more sun than others, but still prefers a little shade in GA. It is a great ornamental plant for the shade. Delightful!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 12-15 "tall, 20" in bloom overall, by 20" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. This selection forms a mound of mid-sized leaves that are gently lobed and wine-red in colour.
- **Flower:** Dark red stems produce lovely sprays of small white and pink bell-shaped flowers above neat mounds of foliage over a long season.

Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.
