- <u>Use:</u> Coral-bells will always be popular garden perennials, putting on an airy display of flowers above a low mound of rounded leaves. This is part of the HEUREKA<sup>™</sup> series, which are new varieties, that exhibit exciting colours on dense, short plants. This selection features large, velvety, lobed amber leaves with a silver marbled overlay and rosepink undersides. Flowers are insignificant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun (afternoon shade)-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth:* Fast growth to 6-8" tall, 12" in bloom overall, by 10-12" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-10; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Semi-evergreen. Soft, velvety amber leaves, silver marbling overlay, and rose-pink undersides.
- *Flower:* Dark red stems produce lovely sprays of small white and pink bell-shaped flowers above neat mounds of foliage over a long season.
