

Kassandra Coral Bells

Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.



- **Use:** This hybrid Coral Bells selection is a terrific choice for adding a touch of colour towards the front of a border in shady areas. Coral Bells offer a dazzling array of foliage color, texture and shapes. Heuchera bearing many dainty flowers make excellent border plants with their neat clumps of evergreen foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 16-20 "tall, and wide in bloom overall. Plant 28" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The leaves emerge in caramel to orange tones, ageing to maroon and reddish-pink during summer. Trim off any withered or tired-looking leaves in spring.
- **Flower:** Taller stems of small white bell flowers appear in late spring.
