

# Limeaide Heuchera



Striking when massed in a woodland border or tucked into a rock garden.



## *Heuchera x 'Limeaide'*

- **Use:** Mouth-watering, lime green foliage with metallic silver highlights creates a tight mound and excellent contrast for its sprays of tiny white flowers. This heat-tolerant villosa hybrid will last longer into summer's heat than other varieties.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; foliage reaches 10 to 12 in. tall, 12 to 14 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Features bright lime green foliage with a silver overlay
- **Flower:** White flowers hover above the blazing leaves.
